Application of Fred Lucas No. 6425

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of August  
A. D. 1935, at Duchesne County of Duchesne  
and State of Utah, in 4 Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Turner presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Ind. Sentence One to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Judge Turner prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Fred Campbell Lucas

I was convicted under the name of Fred Lucas
