First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempt To Rape

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of June A. D. 1934, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in 2nd Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable E. Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One To Twenty Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Wade Johnson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Roy Churchill I was convicted under the name of Buck Harp
