Application of Alfonso Varela

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9 day of March A. D. 1936, at Ogden Utah County of Weber and State of Utah, in 2nd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-Honorable W. M. Johnson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Alfonso Varela I was convicted under the name of Alfonso Varela

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: There were none .

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand larceny

I should like to be deported, if possible.
