Application of Earnest L. Brannan No. 6249

To the Honorable Board of Wardens of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of attempted Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 31, st day of July
A. D. 1934, at Duchesne County of Duchesne
and State of Utah, in Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Martin M. Larson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five years to life in the
Utah State Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Dallas H. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Earnest Loyd Brannan
I was convicted under the name of Earnest Loyd Brannan

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Dewey Miller, Don Allen

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except
Convicted of grand larceny, 1928
