To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd day of October A. D. 1934, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James W. McKenney presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to indeterminate sentence of (5) years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Hardy Gustin prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William O'Reilly I was convicted under the name of Same

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: A. J. Martin

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None
