First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th. day of Sept. A. D. 1935, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge, James W. McKinney presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indt. Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the ~~Parnell Black~~ Utah State Prison
