Application of Darwin E. Mangum

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December  
A. D. 1932, at Manti County of Wasatch  
and State of Utah, in Seventh Judicial Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Woolley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Fred Kellar prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Elbert Darwin Mangum

I was convicted under the name of Darwin Elbert Mangum

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows:

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as record shows
