Application of Arling J. Clark

and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 9th day of October
A. D. 1933, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable James W. Mc Kinney presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to ten years in the Utah
State Prison
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Calvin W. Rawlins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Arling Jesse Clark
I was convicted under the name of Arling J. Clark
