Application of Don Allen No. 6281

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a TERMINATION
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah state prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 2nd day of August
A. D. 1934, at Duchesne County of Duchesne
and State of Utah, in fourth judicial district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Martain M. Larsen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to five years to life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah state prison
Salt Lake City Utah.

Fourth-Honorable Dallas H. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Donald Desro Allen
I was convicted under the name of Don Allen

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Ernest Lloyd Brennan and
Dewey Miller

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None
