Application of ELIZABETH DROUBAY No. 5994

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a COMMUTATION OF SENTENCE and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in THE UTAH STATE PRISON under conviction and a sentence on a charge of MURDER 1st DEGREE

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of MAY, A. D. 1933, at SALT LAKE CITY County of SALT LAKE and State of Utah, in THE THIRD JUDICIAL DISTRICT Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable ALLEN G. THURMAN presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to LIFE. and thereafter was imprisoned in the UTAH STATE PRISON.

Fourth-Honorable CALVIN RAWLINGS prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is ELIZABETH DROUBAY I was convicted under the name of ELIZABETH DROUBAY

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: NONE.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except NONE.
