Application of Alfred J. Bird No. 5774

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Embroiderment

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of January A. D. 1937, at Richfield County of Sevier and State of Utah, in Said Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable W. J. Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Henry C. Beal prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Alfred James Bird I was convicted under the name of Alfred J. Bird

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None
