Application of Bob Mason No. 5451

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Car theft

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27 day of April A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Mc Conkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Twenty days to Ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Carl Roland Mason I was convicted under the name of Bob Mason
