I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 06 day of October
A. D. 1931, at Glucerne County of Glucerne
and State of Utah, in Distric Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Worthing presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to five years to life
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary

Fourth-Honorable Dist. Atty. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Joseph H. Samsel
I was convicted under the name of Jack Peseeman
