First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in U.S.P. under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd day of May A. D. 1932, at Beaver City County of Beaver and State of Utah, in 5th district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Cox presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 6 months to 3 years and thereafter was imprisoned in the U.S.P.

Fourth-Honorable A. Murdoch prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Howard Thompson I was convicted under the name of Howard Thompson
