Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 2 and 4 day of April 1932 A. D. at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in Provo City Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Maurice Harding presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One Year and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah County Jail

Fourth-Honorable Brockbank prosecuted the case.
