Application of James Wilson No. 5917

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ~~unlimited~~ commutation and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Receiving money of Antinville

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 29th day of October A. D. 1932, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 3rd District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Moffatt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve from 3 months to 2 years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ed Guilty prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Randall Anderson I was convicted under the name of James Wilson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Carl Lund & Wm. Hill the driver whom received my funds

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except at Cedar Rapids Iowa January 23, 1924 to January 24, 1924 and while there received my discharge from the Army on Army number names Randall Anderson from Gary & James Wilson from Army in Texas by order of Civil Court.
