Application of Manuel Robledo No. 5718

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3d degree burglary.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of Nov. 1931
A. D. 1931, at Logan County of Cache
and State of Utah, in the first district Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin G. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to term of 6 months to 3 years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Mr. Horsley prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Manuel Robledo
I was convicted under the name of Manuel Robledo

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Sam Harris, James Dillon

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except on record.
