Application of Max Stanton Smith No. 4642

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole (Parole) and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd Degree & Assault with Deadly Weapon with intent to Murder

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of December A. D. 1925, at Salt Lake City & Tooele County of Salt Lake & Tooele and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Chris Mathison presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Maxwell Stanton Smith I was convicted under the name of Max Stanton Smith

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
