Application of Walter J. Levann No. 5920

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of November  
A. D. 1932, at Brigham City Utah County of Box Elder  
and State of Utah, in the first district Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve one to ten years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Wesley Horeley prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Edward Joseph Hogan  
I was convicted under the name of Walter J. Levann

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: I don't know as they were strangers to me

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except 2<sup>nd</sup> degree burglary  
1928 - Car theft, 1930 - 2<sup>nd</sup> degree burglary, 1926
