Application of Lloyd E. Drummond

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Wilful Neglect

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 20th day of June A. D. 1932, at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in 4th District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Worthen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to a term of from one day to eighteen months and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Penitentiary

Fourth-Honorable Attorney Pape prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Lloyd Ellsworth Drummond I was convicted under the name of Lloyd Ellsworth Drummond

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except The one I am now serving time for.
