Application of Albert L. Moore No. 5838

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 12 day of May A. D. 1932, at Padem County of Wasatch and State of Utah, in Second Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Rankin presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an intermediate sentence of one to ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Attorney Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Albert Langford Moore I was convicted under the name of Albert Langford Moore

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as rec-ord reads
