Application of Chris Hammer No. 6001

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 2th day of May A. D. 1933, at Brigham County of Box Elder and State of Utah, in Third district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to from one to Ten years in Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable W. E. Dennis prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Chris Hammer I was convicted under the name of Chris Hammer

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except For Bad Checks in 1923 served six months in Utah State Prison
