Application of Frank Henderson No. 4939

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The U.S.P under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 19 day of Dec A.D. 1932, at Ogden Utah County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to the Utah State Prison To serve from one to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison at Salt Lake City Utah

Fourth-Honorable Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Gal Johnson

I was convicted under the name of Frank Henderson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Frank Smith and Jack Brack

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except this one that I am now serving that I am not guilty of committing and under a name that I have never used
