Application of Jack Wilson No. 5827

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Determination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary - 2 deg

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the May 3 day of May A. D. 1932, at Farmington County of Davis and State of Utah, in V. Gudge Pratt Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable V. Gudge Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1 to 20 yrs

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Mr Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Jack Wilson

I was convicted under the name of Jack Wilson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Walter Peters, Paul Weldon

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as the records show
