Application of Joseph A. Hungiker No. _____

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake County Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Simple assault.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd day of July A. D. 1933, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake County and State of Utah, in Third Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Roger J. McBlough presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Six months.

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County Jail, Salt Lake City - Utah.

Fourth-Honorable Harley W. Justin prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Joseph A. Hungiker. I was convicted under the name of Joseph A. Hungiker.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Ed Montag, Charles Cole, Mel Bean, Walter Herland.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Sentenced from Post Logan Co. for a felony while in the United States Army. No previous convictions from Civilian authorities.
