Application of Andrew Garcia, No. 5980

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination, and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in U. S. P. under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Marijuana;

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th. day of March A. D. 1933, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Allen G. Thurman, presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to ~~twelve~~ exceed five years. and thereafter was imprisoned in the U. S. P.
