I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of June
29th day of January
A. D. 1929
1932, at Panguitch and Richfield County of Garfield and Sevier
and State of Utah, in the Sixth District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Bates presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one (1) to twenty (20) years (on each charge)
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Olaf Michelson and Henry Beal prosecuted the case.
