Application of Lamont McDonald No. 5817

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Remission and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Botlegger Chapter 54

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 12 day of April A. D. 1932, at Parowan County of Iron and State of Utah, in 5th District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Cox presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Three (3) months to Two (2) years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Iron Co. Jail at Parowan Utah April 13 1932

Fourth-Honorable District Atty Jason prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Lamont McDonald I was convicted under the name of Lamont McDonald

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Misdemeanor Jamil possession of one pint liquor Feb. 1930 fined \$30.00 Sept 1930 for same
