Application of Cleland Durfee

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Persistent Violation Liquor Law

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 17th day of January, A. D. 1931, at Provo, Utah County of Utah and State of Utah, in the Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable A. B. Watkins presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Cleland Durfee

I was convicted under the name of Same.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Sherman Cleveland.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
