Application of Maurin Wulffenstein No. 5311

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination or parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The State prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Possession

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 7 day of Jan A. D. 1930, at St George County of Washington and State of Utah, in 5th District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George P. Collier presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve 3 months to 2 years in State prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the State prison

Fourth-Honorable A. L. Larson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Maurin Wulffenstein I was convicted under the name of Maurin Wulffenstein

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except I was fined \$35.00 for possession of whiskey
