I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 3rd degree burglary.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 4th day of March
A. D. 1930, at Provo County of Utah

and State of Utah, in 4th District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge A. D. Watterson presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Six months to Three years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison at Salt Lake
City Utah

Fourth-Honorable Prosecuting Atty. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Raymond Warren Underwood

I was convicted under the name of Raymond W. Underwood

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Frank Phillips

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except at Springfield
City Missouri Oct. 18th 1924
