Application of Walter D Johnson No. 5304

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of obtaining goods under false pretence

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 18 day of Dec A. D. 1929, at Logan County of Casch and State of Utah, in First-district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to indeterminate term of 1 to 10 yrs and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah prison

Fourth-Honorable George Prestony prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Walter D Johnson I was convicted under the name of Same

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Led Stoddard

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None
