Application of Joe Karagas No. 535-1

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 3d day of March, A. D. 1930, at Farmington County of Davis and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable E. E. Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-Honorable G. D. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Joe Karagas I was convicted under the name of same

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except none
