To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 25 day of October A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable David W Moffitt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Five and Twenty years in the Utah State Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Calvin W Pawlings prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Sorenson I was convicted under the name of William Sorenson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Thomas Lock

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Being Drunk
