I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary Second Degree

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd, day of February, A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Mr. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Ray Vancott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is J. D. Harrison I was convicted under the name of J. D. Harrison

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
