Application of Louis Montez No. 5176

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Possession of Marijuana

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of April, A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.
