I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of 2nd Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd day of March A. D. 1931, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Moffat presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William G. Gilbert I was convicted under the name of Jack Kearns

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Henry La Flue

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Done a term of 3 years in Jackson Penitentiary Michigan.
