I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 19th day of September  
A. D. 1931, at Monte County of Kane  
and State of Utah, in South District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Mr Helworth Woolley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty (1+20) years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Mr Fred W Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Willie Benjamin Johnson  
I was convicted under the name of Willie B Johnson

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
