Application of Louis S. Eib No. 5376

To the Honourable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 19 day of April
A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable David W. Moffat presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to five to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Beath prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Louis Swisher Eib

I was convicted under the name of Louis S. Eib
