Application of Malberto Basajas No. 5065

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a conditional termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the state prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of highway robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10 day of September A. D. 1928, at Brigham City County of Boxelder and State of Utah, in the first district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge M. C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to five years to life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the state prison at Salt Lake City, Utah.

Fourth-Honorable Le Roy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Malberto Basajas I was convicted under the name of Malberto Basajas

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Salvador Cordero, Vincent Alvaray
