To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Injuring County Property and Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the fourth day of April 1929 at Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County of Utah and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Oscar W. McConkie

Third-I was sentenced to an Indeterminate Term of from 5 years To Life an Indeterminate Term of not more than 5 Years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray VanCott M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Elmer Clark Cole I was convicted under the name of Charles Clark Elmer C. Cole

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Orson Meacham on the Robbery charge. Unknown on the lesser charge.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as records show.
