Application of Royal McKean No.

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake County Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Petit Larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of December A. D. 1931, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in City Court Court, in and for the

County and State aforesaid, Honorable James Stump presiding. An appeal was made and the District court upheld the above sentence. Jan. 18, 1932, Salt Lake City, Utah. Hon. James McKinney, presiding: Third-I was sentenced to 180 days in the County Jail and upheld by the District Court. (Six months)

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County Jail, S.L. City, Utah.

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Royal McKean

I was convicted under the name of Royal McKean
