Application of Henry Popper

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 29 day of July
A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable David W. Moffat presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Twenty Years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Behin W. Rawlins prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Henry Popper

I was convicted under the name of Henry Popper

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Carl Eddy + Harry Gross

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except As Records Show
