Application of Roy Dean No. 5413

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of June A. D. 1930, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James H. Wolfe presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to An Indeterminate Sentence and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Roy Van Cott prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Roy Dean I was convicted under the name of Roy Dean

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except What Records Show
