Application of Harris Murray

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Commutation of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Murder

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 11th day of December A. D. 1929, at Terminal County of Uintah and State of Utah, in Fourth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge E. Hansen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Life Imprisonment

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.
