I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah state Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd day of June A. D. 1929, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in Judicial Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah state Prison

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Walter Henry Scott I was convicted under the name of Walter Henry Scott
