First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of September,  
A. D. 1927, at Ogden County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. N. Kimball presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth--Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is W. T. Short  
I was convicted under the name of same

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
