Application of Robert Custer No. 5254.

On the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole or Conditional Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of October A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in (3rd) Judicial Dist. Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McKel Judge presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to An Indeterminate Term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Calvin W. Rawlings prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Robert Custer
I was convicted under the name of Robert Custer.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None

Sixth:- As I have no one to which to be paroled to I am asking to be paroled to the State Parole Agent. As I have lost my parents I give this as my reason. I resided in Ogden for 5 yrs.
