under conviction and a sentence on a charge of perjury

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 26 day of Sept
A. D. 1928, at Cedars, County of Weaver
and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
at Sugar House, Utah

Fourth-Honorable City of Ensign prosecuted the case.
