I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree Burglary

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th day of February A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in The Third Judicial Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term in the state Prison and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Frederick William Ross I was convicted under the name of David Ross

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None!

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except None!
